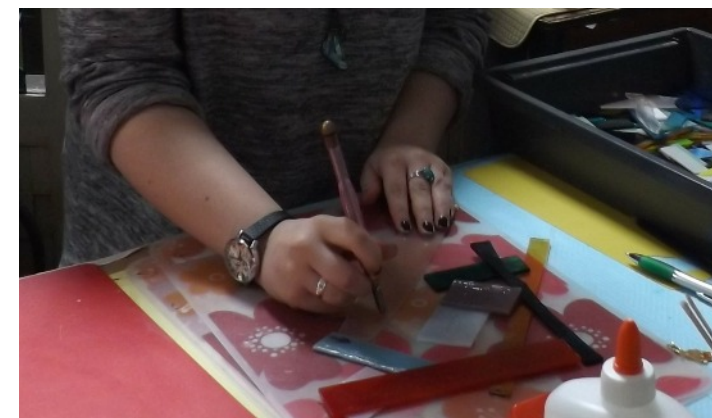

Beginner jewellery workshop

A great introduction to working with glass and to fusing. You will learn the basics of glass cutting and how it likes to fuse in the kiln. A variety of effects can be achieved by controlling the temperature of the kiln. Rachel will keep you right with the technical side and there is lots of samples to inspire you and give you ideas, but the design, size, colour and shape is up to you.

Introduction to Glass Fusing

A one day workshop, project based, designed to learn you how to fuse glass in a kiln using a variety of techniques and glass products. There are 4 projects and a demonstration on how to prepare kiln shelves and moulds for slumping. As well as a compatibility test to determine COE of glass. Normally over one day, however this can be adapted over 2 shorter days, if preferred.

Beginner Stained Glass

On this one-day taster session, you will learn all the basics of the methods for traditional copper foiling, also known as Tiffany work. During the course of the day you will learn to cut glass freestyle, then cut glass following a pattern. You will also learn how to use the tools involved and proceed to grinding the glass, applying copper foil and burnishing it. You will then learn how to solder it together. The actual project is a 6-point star. It has an internal curve, an external curve and a straight line, and is a repeat pattern.

Total cost is £75

(This includes use of all tools and equipment, glass and materials for project, light refreshments on arrival and throughout the day and personal one-to-one tuition).
